SOLAR ECLIPSE PINHOLE PROJECTOR

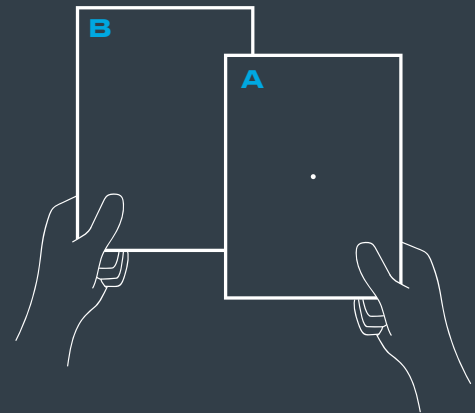
Take a pin and poke a hole through the center of this card (Card A). Hold the two cards with your back to the sun.

Align the two cards so that the sun projects through the pinhole on this card (Card A) onto Card B.

Enjoy the Great American Solar Eclipse, but remember: never stare directly at the sun! Even through the pinhole.

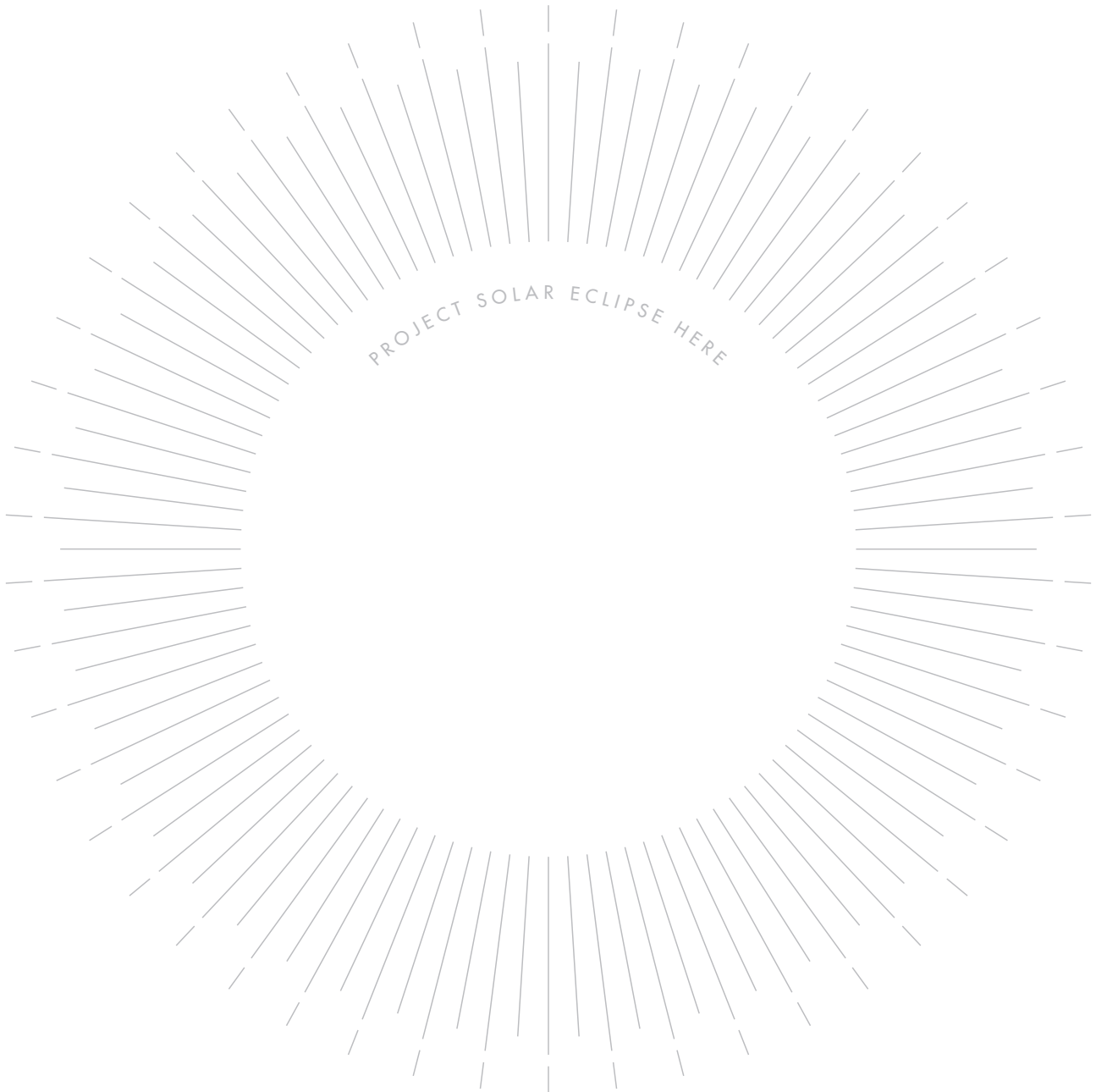
