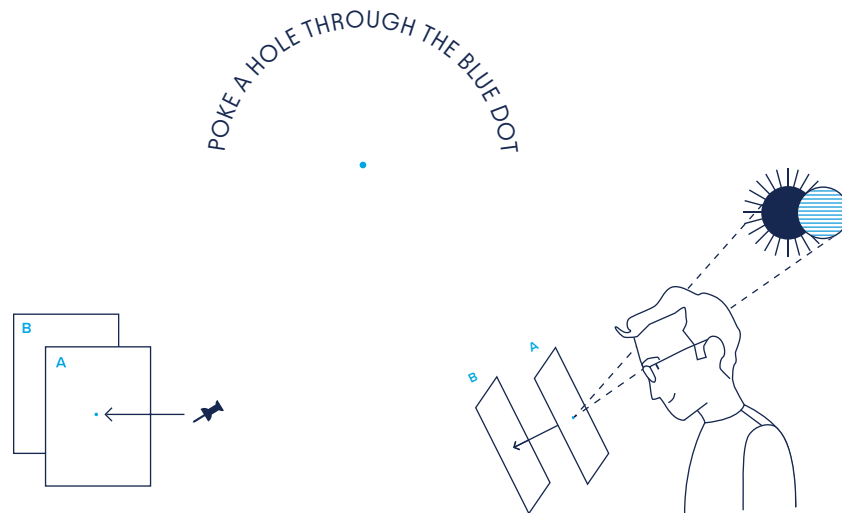

SOLAR ECLIPSE PINHOLE PROJECTOR

If you need a safe way to view (and enjoy!) the solar eclipse on April 8, print out and follow the instructions on sheets A and B to create your own, personal pinhole projector.



1. Take a pin and poke a hole through the center of this card (Card A). Hold the two cards with your back to the sun.

2. Align the two cards so that the sun projects through the pinhole on this card (Card A) onto Card B.

WARNING!

While enjoying the Great North American Solar Eclipse, please remember that you should **never** stare directly at the sun—even through the pinhole.

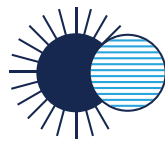
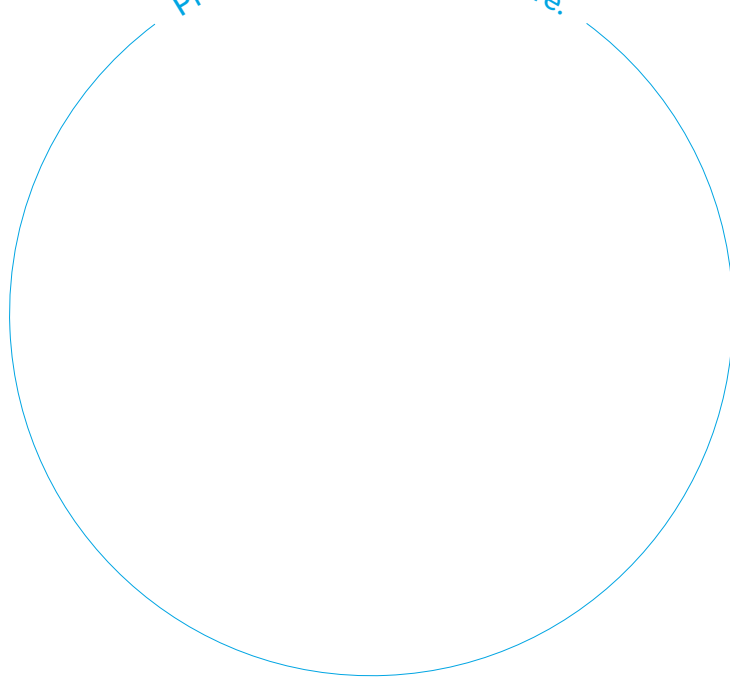
